## AT THE ACADEMY

There has been some confusion regarding what is to be worn by Correctional Officer Cadets at the Richard A. McGee Academy. Hopefully, this will clear up much/most of that.

As of the date of this writing, the following are approved training uniforms for Academy Cadets:

- **Training Trousers (2)- CDCR Approved**, green cargo trousers. United Uniform #10296 (men) and #W10296 (women).
- **Training Shirts (2)- CDCR Approved**, tan, short sleeve poly/rayon shirts. Be sure to look for the "This garment meets or exceeds CDCR uniform specifications and has been approved by CDCR" tab inside! Again, this is the short sleeve poly/rayon shirt. United Uniform #11101
- **Foul Weather Jacket (1)- CDCR Approved**, green. Tact Squad (Frontline) #F1003G. This jacket is optional from May-October.
- **Duty Gear- Can be nylon or leather (option)**. Tact Squad molded, ballistic nylon (ours it not polyester!) is approved and a great choice!




### What about GRADUATION?

This is where I have seen the most confusion, and heard the most questions. Prior to about January/February, 2018, Cadets had the option of graduating in their regular training uniform (green approved cargos and approved S/S Class-B shirt, OR they could opt for the approved L/S Class-A shirt with Class-A pants. Beginning in about February, 2018, **NO CADET MAY WEAR CLASS-A PANTS FOR GRADUATION!** As of today (June 1, 2018), Cadets are still allowed to graduate in the approved line duty cargo pants, with either a short or long sleeve CDCR approved Class-A/B shirt with tie. However, the correct graduation set is:

**Pants-** Class-B internal cargo pant. United Uniform approved style #10136 (74/24/2 ProFlex)

**Shirt-** Class-A long sleeve CDCR approved Class-A shirt with tie. United Uniform approved style #11106
